Let's talk about NOISE.

Several of you at the past event were contacted regarding the sound level of your exhaust. We have a lot of new faces, and I'm trying to be as accommodative as I can be, and fortunately on Sunday, the wind was coming back at us in the pits, so this mitigated the issue a touch, but there were at least 4 cars that were too loud. If this issue was discussed with you, PLEASE find a way to quiet your car down. We do not run by SCCA sound meter rules at our site. We are very fortunate to have this site, but if we get noise complaints, we run the risk of losing it. If you think it's too loud, then it probably is.

Our tech inspectors have full authority to not pass your car for inspection if they feel it's too loud. If you want a second opinion, it can be brought to me, but I cannot be as lenient as I was at the past event. If you are too loud, you won't be permitted to keep running.

We are expecting between 10 and 20 exotic cars on Saturday. They will be using our novice school track after lunch. So, if you want to see some really cool cars, be sure to show up this weekend.

# 2015 Trophy Rules Gulfcoast Autocrossers, LTD



- The 2015 season will consist of ten events held at Buckingham Airfield.
- To qualify for year-end class champion, the following requirements must be met:
  - Must compete in at least eight events in the 2015 series.
  - Must compete in at least eight events in the same car class.
- At the end of the series, a class champion award will be given to the person with the most points in the class, based on the following:
  - Points from the best eight of ten events will be counted
  - b. In the event of a tie, the ninth event will determine the tie breaker.
- All results and class designations will be final at the end of each event.
- 5. Points cannot be transferred from one class to another class. (Note: It is the driver's responsibility to know what class they belong in)

Numbers must be readable and correct. We follow SCCA standards when it comes to numbering standards. Your numbers should be a minimum of 8" tall, with a bold stroke, no less than 1.25" thick. Class letters must be a minimum of 4" tall with a 0.75" stroke. Additionally, the colors selected should be of high-contrast as compared to your car color. They should be easily readable from the timing and scoring RV.

Shoe polish and tape numbers ARE NOT PERMITTED. You must have your car number, and class letters installed, before tech inspection. Paper numbers and class letters are available for sale in the tech area.
